Roger founded Practitioner Supplies, a specialist supplier to colon hydrotherapists and has designed much equipment we use today. He has run popular postgraduate workshops since 1993 and has been closely involved with the evolution of ARCH over the years and as a director of the General Naturopathic Council is involved in the future regulation of our therapy.
